2020 AMMI Canada Lifetime Achievement Award

This award acknowledges outstanding nationally or internationally recognized contributions in clinical or basic research or advocacy in the fields of infectious diseases or medical microbiology by a member of AMMI Canada. The monetary value of the AMMI Canada Lifetime Achievement award is \$1,000 CDN.

Nomination Process and Requirements:

1. Two nominators (one within and one outside the nominee's institution) are required. Both nominators must be Active AMMI Canada members in good standing.
2. The nomination should include:
 - i. Nominee's name, contact information, and affiliation(s);
 - ii. A brief professional biography of the nominee (3-page maximum; NIH Biosketch or abbreviated CIHR format); and
 - iii. A narrative summary of the nominee's career accomplishments to be used at the awards ceremony and in publications. **NOTE: This summary is required for the nominee to be considered for this award (1-2 pages).** The summary should include evidence of the following contributions (as relevant):
 - A brief overview of the nominee's career
 - Major contributions to the acquisition and dissemination of knowledge in the fields of infectious diseases and/or medical microbiology
 - Lifetime achievement in public health
 - Contributions to clinical practice in infectious diseases
 - Contributions (direct or indirect) to patient care that have significantly advanced the practice of infectious diseases and/or medical microbiology
 - Mentoring and/or teaching to fellows, residents, or medical students that demonstrates excellence as a clinician and/or researcher who is able to motivate the next generation of infectious diseases and medical microbiology clinicians and researcher.
 - Advocacy that has resulted in improved patient care
 - Other relevant contributions
 - Posthumous nominees are permitted
 - iv. A letter of support from each of the nominators outlining why the nominee should be considered for this award in the context of the narrative summary

Review Process: All nominations will be reviewed by the AMMI Canada Grants & Awards Committee, who will make a recommendation to the AMMI Canada Council. The final decision will be made by the AMMI Canada Council.

Nominators and winners will be notified of the Council's decision in **February 2021**. If no nominations are received or meet the criteria, no award will be granted for that year.
