You will also collaborate with hospitalists, internal medicine specialists and other specialties.

Abbotsford Regional Hospital and Cancer Centre is located on the traditional, ancestral and unceded territories of the Stó:lō (staw-low) people, particularly the Semá:th (Sumas) [sue-mass] and Matsqui [matssqwee] First Nations. It is a 302 bed, University of British Columbia affiliated hospital offering medical, surgical, obstetrics, inpatient pediatrics, renal, cardiology, tertiary palliative care, helipad, as well as 24/7 emergency services with 77,032 visits annually.

Additional services include inpatient, OPAT, and Rapid Access clinics; general infectious diseases, multi-drug resistant organisms, tuberculosis, returning travelers and immunosuppressed hosts.
