The successful candidate will provide clinical expertise across the full spectrum of pediatric infectious diseases inpatient, outpatient, Urgent Consultation Service, and ambulatory clinic settings, and on-call services. This position may be filled by more than one physician depending on the Section's needs.

The Section of Pediatric Infectious Diseases works closely with colleagues in the Section of Pediatric Oncology/Bone Marrow Transplantation, Pediatric Immunology, Emergency Medicine, Hospital Pediatrics and Pediatric intensive Care. We are a regional bone marrow transplant center. Areas of special clinical interest such as infections in the immunocompromised host, transplant-related infections and clinical aspects of vaccine impact, safety and hesitancy are additionally highly valued.
