

Infectious Disease Clinician with Special Expertise in HIV

The Department of Medicine (<http://www.departmentofmedicine.com>) in the Cumming School of Medicine, University of Calgary and Alberta Health Services (<http://www.albertahealthservices.ca>) invites applications for a permanent position as an Infectious Disease Clinician-Scientist at the Clinical Assistant Professor level with additional expertise in the care and management of those individuals infected with HIV.

Candidates must have evidence of strong clinical training and performance in the investigation and management of all infectious diseases and their clinical mimics. The successful candidate will also be an individual who has experience and expertise in HIV and AIDS outpatient care. Specifically, the individual will be experienced and knowledgeable with the diversity of current and imminent anti-retroviral therapies, the management of long-standing and emerging HIV-related comorbidities and the social determinants of HIV health.

Primary clinical responsibilities will at various times include; providing inpatient general infectious disease consultancy services, (including weekend & night call), practicing within a busy but highly effective outpatient antimicrobial treatment program and outpatient HIV clinics administered through the auspices of the Southern Alberta HIV Clinic (SAC). These activities will entail working effectively with allied health colleagues and supervising and educating medical trainees as well as fully participating in collaborative clinical research. The ability to work collaboratively with other infectious disease/medical microbiology colleagues is essential and the successful applicant will be expected to be a regular contributor to ID section rounds and presentations. Remuneration for this position will be through a Fee-For -Service mechanisms for general infectious disease care, and a sessional contract or alternatively a cARP for each HIV clinic. The position can be adjusted based on the needs of the successful recruit to achieve a 0.7-1.0 Full Time Equivalent status. All documentation will be conducted within the Provincial EMR (ConnectCare).

Alberta Health Services operates five teaching hospitals in the city of Calgary, including the new South Health Campus acute care facility. Clinicians are expected to be competent and engaged teachers for a range of medical trainees (i.e. medical students, off-service residents, internal medicine residents and infectious disease sub-speciality residents), inspiring the next generation of physicians. AHS serves 1.8 million residents of Southern Alberta, Southeastern British Columbia and Southwestern Saskatchewan. The Department of Medicine provides academic and clinical services in an integrated manner across all hospital sites and in several ambulatory care settings. Outpatient HIV care is centralized at the Southern Alberta HIV Clinic (SAC) in the Sheldon M. Chumir Centre, which provides longitudinal consultancy level care for the 2300 individuals living with HIV throughout Southern Alberta.

The Department of Medicine, Cumming School of Medicine, University of Calgary and Calgary Zone, Alberta Health Service seeks to recruit and retain a diverse and inclusive workforce that will contribute to creating the future of health. We are committed to fostering diversity through
